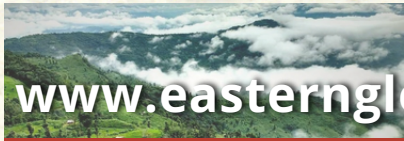

Wings of Heritage and A Symphony of Traditions

As the hornbill spreads its wings, so do the cultures of Nagaland — soaring together in harmony.



The Hornbill Festival is a vibrant cultural event held annually from December 1st to 10th at the Naga Heritage Village in Kisama, Nagaland, India. Also known as the "Festival of Festivals," it brings together the 17 distinct tribes of Nagaland to celebrate and preserve their rich heritage through traditional music, dance, crafts, and cuisine.

The festival, named after the revered hornbill bird, aims to promote inter-tribal interaction, boost tourism, and showcase the cultural diversity and traditions of the Naga people.

Highlights of the festival



Tribal Dance Performances: Traditional war dances, folk performances, and ceremonial acts by 17 major Naga tribes.



Folk and Rock Music: From traditional tribal tunes to electrifying rock performances during the Hornbill International Rock Contest.

Ethnic Cuisine: Taste authentic Naga delicacies like smoked pork, bamboo shoot dishes, millet beer, and fiery chutneys.

Handicrafts & Exhibitions: Local artisans showcase bamboo and cane products, handwoven textiles, jewelry, and tribal weapons.

Traditional Sports & Contests: Wrestling, archery, indigenous games, and even chili-eating contests!

Evening Cultural Programs: Campfires, storytelling, fashion shows, and fusion musical nights create an unforgettable vibe.



How to Reach There



BY AIR

- Dimapur Airport (74 km from Kohima) – Connected by road via taxis and buses.
- Guwahati Airport – Travel to Dimapur by road, then onward to Kohima.

BY TRAIN

- Dimapur Railway Station (DMV) – Well-connected by taxis and buses to Kohima.
- Guwahati Railway Station – Travel to Dimapur by road or rail, then proceed to Kohima.

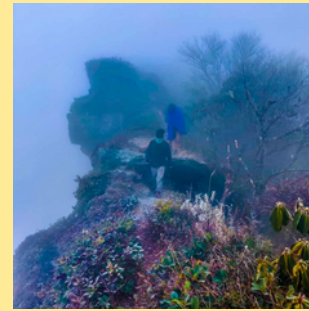

Two room types: Safari Room & Tea Garden Room

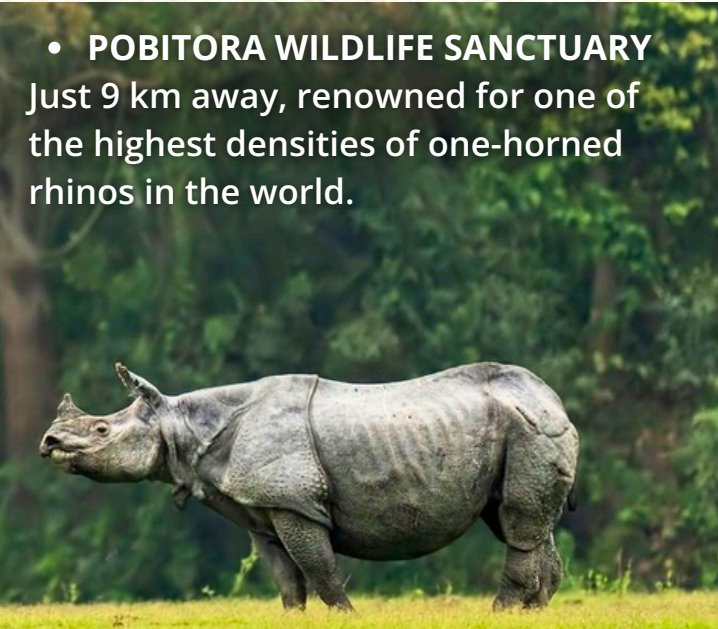


FACILITIES & EXPERIENCES

WHERE CULTURE, ECOLOGY, AND RITUAL CONVERGE IN BONGAIGAON



In Assam's Bongaigaon district, Mahadev Pahar (Mahadev Hill) stands as a modest yet culturally rich landmark.

Every year in March, during the month of Phagun, locals gather here for the Khahi Khowa Utsav — a unique festival where goat meat is ritually prepared and offered to Lord Shiva. Rooted in the Bijni kingdom under Queen Abhayeshwari, this tradition has grown from a sacred ritual into a vibrant communal celebration of faith and togetherness.

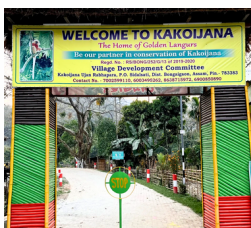
